Wi-Fi Internet Access Connection Procedure

WINDOWS XP

The library has provided wireless network service to connect your personal laptop to the World Wide Web while at your public library. All you need is a laptop, wireless adapter (Wi-Fi) and web browser. (NOTE: Your web browser must have cookies enabled to access the internet.)

The following section describes in detail how to connect to a wireless network using the **network icon on the taskbar** in Windows XP. This document presumes that you have the appropriate permissions on your laptop to setup a wireless connection. NOTE: Windows XP has additional security features that may periodically ask you if you want to continue making changes during the wireless setup process.

1. To get started, right click on the wireless icon in the taskbar.





2. Click on View Available Wireless Networks



3. A list of wireless networks will be displayed. These are all the networks that are within range of your computer. Find the network that displays the **Library's Name** and click on it. *(Ex."MainLibrary")*



4. Now click on the Connect button.



5. Next you will see the wireless icon working to connect to the network.
